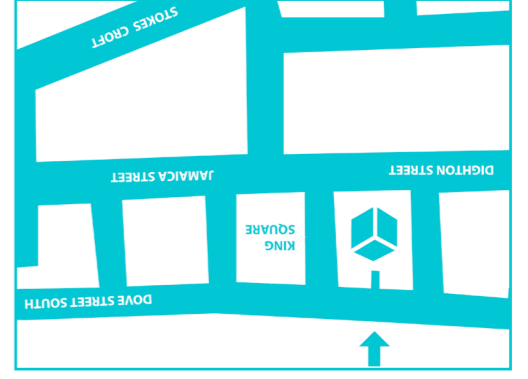

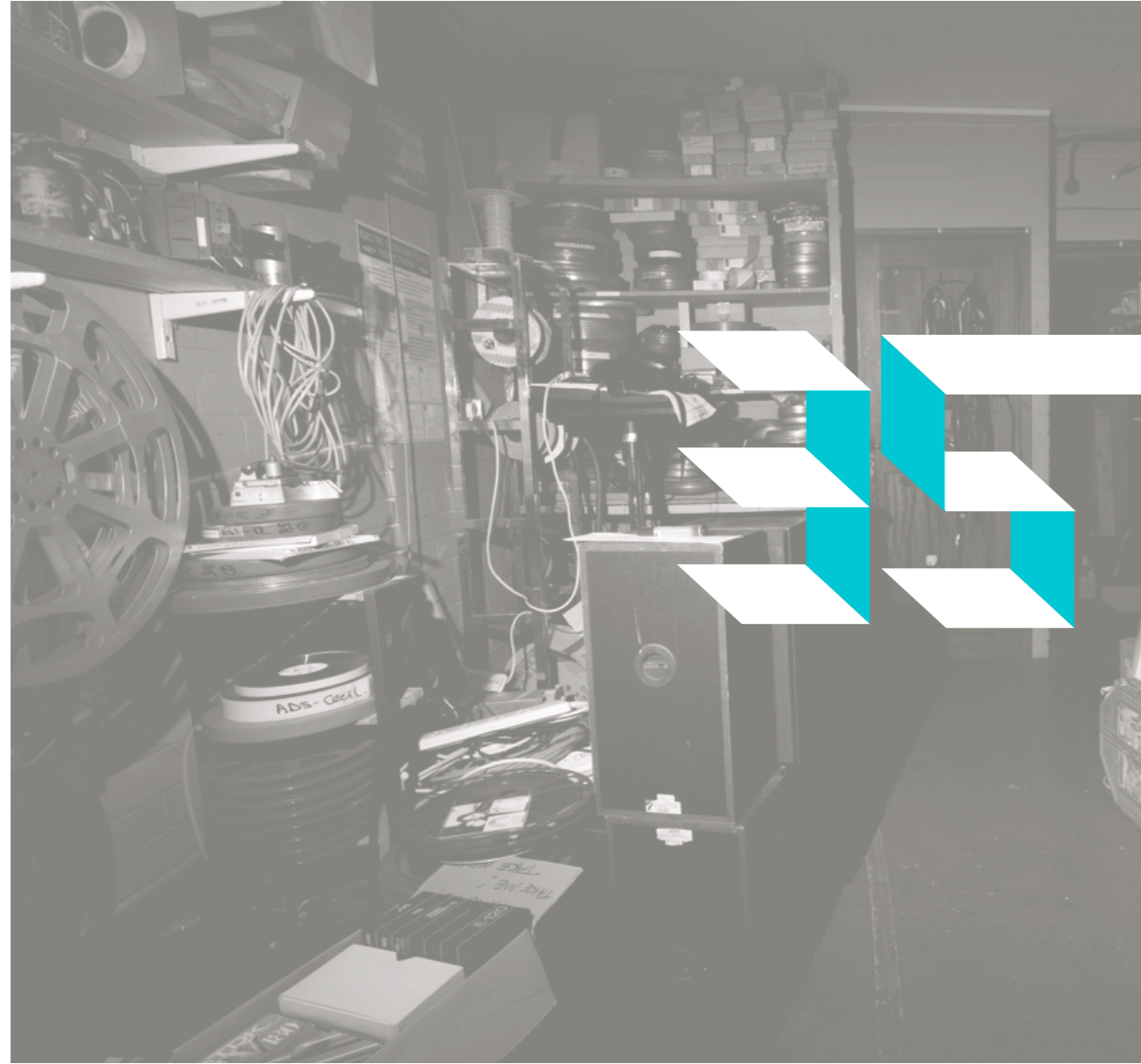

THE DEATH OF 35MM FILM*

The Cube's ability to screen the full range of film titles it would like has been reduced over recent years as film distributors have begun to release films on digital formats rather than 35mm. The move towards digital distribution models has reduced the costs for film distributors while imposing costly new equipment on film exhibitors. This possibly negates one of digital's potential benefits in opening access

to filmmakers with new and different voices as small independent cinemas struggle to make the leap to digital and the marketplace is increasingly dominated by multiplexes showing a standardised product. With this in mind, we'd like to acknowledge the support of the Barn Cinema (Dartington) in loaning us their digital cinema and sound processing equipment while we cobble together the parts!

**The Cube remains committed to 35mm as a format. A possible future for The Cube lies in developing a film lab to allow artists and filmmakers to experiment with the chemical processes and production of the medium.*
